Benjamin Scrogin (F45) was a son of John Scrogin (E14) and Rachel Kendrick who moved to Shelby County, Kentucky, from Bourbon County, Kentucky.<sup>1</sup> Pamela M. Bohannon was a daughter of William Bohannon and Jane Wilcoxson.<sup>2</sup> Her name usually was spelled Pamela and frequently Permelia, which probably was the way it was pronounced. Her name may have been Pamela.

Benjamin Scrogin and Pamela Bohannon were married on 08 October 1833 in Shelby County, Kentucky, by the Baptist preacher Abraham Cook:<sup>3</sup>

Know all men by these presents, That we, Benjamin Scroggan and William Bohannon are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in the sum of L50 to the payment whereof, well and truly be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this 1st day of October 1833.

The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas a marriage is shortly intended to be solemnized between the above bound Benjamin Scroggan and Pamela Bohannon of this county; Now, shall it always hereafter appear, that there is no just cause to obstruct the said marriage, then the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.

The birth date of Benjamin Scrogin (F45) is questionable. It appears on his tombstone as 24 January 1811 but that conflicts with the birth of his older brother Samuel Scrogin (F90) whose tombstone is engraved with a birth date of 14 June 1810; a six-month difference. One must be in error and it probably is Benjamin's. Since their parents were married on 02 February 1808 and their first child was a daughter Elizabeth, Samuel could not have been born in June 1809. Benjamin must have been born on either 24 June 1811 or 24 January 1812, with the error arising from a misreading for Jun for Jan, or vice versa, in a past transcription. The birthday of Pamela Bohannon Scrogin and her children; some of their marriages, and their death dates were recorded in the Bohannon Bible:<sup>4</sup>

On the flyleaf of the Bible was written:

William Bohannon born 1786, April 19th died Oct 3rd 1865

There are discrepancies between the birth dates of Louisa and Frances Scroggin, and the death date of Frances, in the Bible and on their tombstones. Also, Frances' middle initial is given as M. in the Bible and as A. on her tombstone.

Benjamin Scroggin (F45) and Pamela Bohannon Scroggin and three of their children are buried in the cemetery at Indian Fork Baptist Church in Shelby County, not far from Bagdad:<sup>5</sup>

T. Hertell Montfort (1854-1930) and Josie Scroggin Montfort (1855-1922) are buried in the cemetery at Bagdad, Kentucky. At one time, the cemetery at Indian Fork, which had become badly overgrown with brush, was cleared with a bulldozer and the tombstones supposedly were replaced without regard to their original positions. The graves of Benjamin and Pamela Bohannon Scrogin were marked by a tall obelisk upon which their names are engraved Benjamin Scrogins and Permelia Scrogins, His wife. The letter from his father John Scrogin in Iowa in 1850 was addressed to Benjamin Scrogin. The final e on Benjamin was a fancy affectation of the time. It was this formal extravagance that accounts for the extra g in Scrogin, although general misspelling was not unusual in those days. Most names received various spellings within a single document, such as: More and Moore; Miles and Myles; Vardeman and Vardiman; Bohanon, Bohanan, Bohannan, Bohannon and Buchanan; Abram and Abraham; Montfort and Monfort; Radcliffe and Ratcliffe; and Scogin, Scogan, Scoggin, Scoggan, Scrogin, Scrogan, Scroggin, Scroggan, Scroggins, Scroggans and Scroghan. However, most early documents follow the spelling Scrogin. The letter from John to Benjamin was signed and addressed Scrogin. The name is spelled and signed Scrogin throughout the original copy of the will of Benjamin but the person who transcribed it into the public record book spelled it with the double-g, excepting for the signature:<sup>6</sup>

Benjamin Scrogin (F45) was also known as Benoni, which was the name of his maternal grandfather Benoni Kendrick who came to Bourbon County, Kentucky, from Culpeper County, Virginia.

On 20 October 1835 Thornton J. Wilson of Boone County, Kentucky, who was married to Maria Kendrick, sister of Rachel Kendrick Scrogin, sold 189 acres in Shelby County, Kentucky, on Six Mile Creek to his nieces and nephews, the children of John Scrogin (E14) and Rachel Kendrick: Elizabeth Moore, Samuel Scrogin, Benoni Scrogin, Irene Miles, Polly Vardiman and Sally Tharp of Shelby County for \$1500.<sup>7</sup> Thornton J. Wilson resided in Bourbon County, Kentucky, on 15 December 1828 when he bought from William Miles of Weakley County, Tennessee, and his wife Rhoda, for \$1500, 189 acres, 3 roods and 25 poles in Shelby County, Kentucky, on Six Mile Creek, including Radcliffs mill dam.<sup>8</sup>

On 16 August 1840 Benjamin and Samuel Scrogin bought 4 1/2 acres in Shelby County on Six Mile Creek from Richard Ratcliff and his wife Ellen:<sup>9</sup>

This Indenture made this 16th day of August Between Richard Ratcliffe & Ellen his wife of the County of Shelby of the one part and Samuel Scroggans & Benjamin Scroggans of the afsd. County of the Other part Witnesseth that ... for and in Consideration of the Sum of four hundred dollars ... hath ... sold ... to ... Benjamin & Samuel Scroggans ... a tract of land in Shelby County on the Waters of Six mile and being Lot No. 7 allotted in the division of the lands of Jno. Radcliffe decd to Richd. Radcliffe &c which is thus bounded Beginning at a beech in Scroggans line ... to a stake near the mill ... containing 4 1/2 acres ...

Benjamin Scrogin was listed on the 1840 census on the line above his brother Samuel:<sup>10</sup>

On 09 October 1840 Samuel and Benjamin Scroggan of Shelby County, Kentucky, bought 16 acres and 32 poles in Shelby County on Six Mile Creek from Noel K. Johnson and his wife Martha W. Johnson of Shelby County for \$97.20. The bounds of the tract ran from a beech in said Samuel and Benjamin Scroggan thence N17 E57 poles to the middle of the road leading from Scroggans mill five feet N of a stone on the south side of said road thence S74 3/4 E49 1/2 poles to the middle of said road 1/2 a pole N of stone on the south side of said road thence S17 W47 1/2 poles to a beech in said Scroggan line thence with said line N86 W50 poles to the beginning.<sup>11</sup> On 07 March 1842 Benjamin and Samuel Scroggin of Shelby County, Kentucky, bought 16 acres in Shelby County on Six Mile Creek from Isaac N. Jacobs and his wife Jane W. Jacobs of Johnston County, Indiana, for \$7.50. The bounds of the tract began at a corner of Noel K. Johnson & the aforesaid Scrogins thence with the said line of Lot No. 5 to where it intersects the old line between the mill tract and Scrogins line thence with said line to a beech corner to Lot No. 6 & 7 thence with the line of Lot No. 7 to Floods road thence to the beginning.<sup>12</sup> On 01 October 1845 Benjamin Scrogins and Samuel Scrogins of Shelby County, Kentucky, bought their sisters' shares of the tract that had been conveyed to the children of John Scrogin by Thornton Wilson:<sup>13</sup>

This indenture made this first day of October in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty five between John More and Elizabeth More his wife daughter of John Scrogins, Abraham Miles and Irean Miles his wife daughter of John Scrogins, Peter Vardeman and Mary Vardeman his wife daughter of John Scrogins, and Joshua Tharp and Sallie Tharp his wife daughter of John Scrogins, of the County of Shelby and State of Kentucky of the one part and Benjamin Scrogins and Samuel Scrogins of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that ... for ... seven hundred and eighty dollars in hand paid viz; to John Moore two hundred dollars, to Abraham Miles one hundred and ninety dollars, to Peter Vardeman one hundred and ninety dollars, and to

Joshua Tharp two hundred dollars ... hath ... sold ... the ... land ... deeded to the heirs of John Scrogins by Thornton Wilson ... situate ... in the County of Shelby on the waters of Six Mile ... containing 189 acres 3 roods 25 poles ...

On 01 October 1845 Benjamin and Pamela Scrogin sold their interest in the mill and mill lot to Samuel Scrogin:<sup>14</sup>

This indenture made this 1st day of October 1845 between Benj. Scroggan & Pamela his wife of the one part & Saml. Scroggin of the other part all of Shelby County Kentucky Witnesseth That the said Benj. Scroggan for ... three hundred and fifteen dollars ... has this day sold ... unto the said Saml. Scroggin ... his interest in and to ... land in ... county of Shelby on the waters of Six Mile Creek containing about four and half acres also his interest in & to the mill pond and mill race which belongs to a mill located on said four acres & a half which said mill pond and mill race are not on said four & a half acres but on lands owned by said Benj. and Saml. Scroggin in partnership. The boundaries of said 4 1/2 acres may be seen by reference to a deed from Rich'd Ratcliff & wife to said Benj. & Saml. Scroggin recorded in the Shelby County Court Clerks Office Book G No. 2 page 196 ... In testimony whereof ... Benj. Scroggin & Pamela his wife hereto subscribed their names & affix their seals the date first above written.

Benjamin Scroggin acknowledged the deed in Shelby County Court on 01 October 1845 and Pamela verified her agreement to the sale on 20 April 1846.

On the same day, 20 April 1846 Samuel Scrogin and Benjamin Scrogin divided the land that they jointly owned:<sup>15</sup>

This indenture made and entered into on this 20th day of April in the year 1846 between Samuel Scroggin & Benjamin Scroggin both of the County of Shelby and State of Kentucky, Witnesseth That the parties to these presents hold jointly and undivided one & eighty nine acre three quarters & 25 poles of land purchased from the heirs of John Scroggin which was previously purchased from William Miles and fifteen acres purchased by the parties to these presents from Noel K. Johnson and about fifteen acres purchased by them from Newton Jacobs making in all two hundred and nineteen acres three quarters & 25 poles now it being the wish of each of the parties to these presents to divide said tracts or parcels of land between themselves have mutually agreed that the said Samuel Scroggin shall have eighty eight acres three quarters & 37 poles lying on the south end of the first mentioned tract and that said Benjamin Scroggin shall have one hundred acres three quarters and 28 poles lying on the north end of said first mentioned tract and also both the other smaller tracts as purchased from said Johnson and Jacobs reserving however to the said Samuel Scroggin a mill dam and race on the two small tracts above mentioned ... to have and to hold the ... tract of land on the south end of the first mentioned tract

(being 111 poles long on the west side & 118 poles long on the east side) to the said Samuel Scrogan ... and to have and to hold the ... tract on the north end of the first mentioned tract together with the two smaller tracts as purchased from Johnson and Jacobs amounting in the whole to one hundred and thirty acres three quarters & 28 poles to the said Benjamin Scroggin ... with the reservations aforesaid and the said Samuel Scroggin and Benjamin for and in consideration of the premises ... agree with each other that ... Samuel Scroggin will warrant and defend the title of the said one hundred and thirty acres three quarters & 28 poles of land to ... Benjamin Scroggin his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever and that ... Benjamin Scroggin will warrant and defend the title of the said 88 acres three quarters and 37 poles of land to the said Samuel Scroggin against the claim or claims of all any every person or persons whatsoever. In witness where of the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and date first above written.

The couples acknowledged the deed in Shelby County Court on 20 April 1846.

On 02 August 1848 Benjamin Scrogin of Shelby County bought 100 acres of land lying in Shelby and Franklin counties, Kentucky, for \$200.00 from James W. and Ethelinda Bacon and Fleming G. Hern. The tract was bounded on the west by Robert T. Sacrey, on the north by Wesley Wade, on the east by James Baskett and Wade, and on the south by George Hewlett. It was the western part of a tract belonging to William Smith which had been previously divided.<sup>16</sup> Benjamin Scrogin was described as of Franklin County, Kentucky, on 22 November 1849 when he obtained a quit claim from W. W. Hearn for his share of interest in the 100 acres, described as being on the waters of Benson Creek, for \$100.00.<sup>17</sup>

Benjamin Scrogin witnessed the oral, death-bed will of his brother Samuel Scrogin on 08 October 1849 with James Miles and Richard Radford, Jr. Miles filed the nuncupative will at the Shelby County Court for November 1849 and at the April Term 1850 he and Benjamin proved it. Letters of administration were then granted to the widow Malinda Scrogin.<sup>18</sup> Malinda Scrogin was a daughter of Samuel Miles.



Benjamin Scroggin of Shelby County bought 3 3/4 acres and 5 poles there from Nathaniel Flood of the same place for \$33.75 on 10 October 1858. The tract was bounded by land of Benjamin Scroggin on the north side of Six Mile Creek corner in Demaree's line and corner to Nathaniel Flood.<sup>19</sup>

On 06 June 1859 Benjamin and Pamela Scroggin of Shelby County sold 7 acres there on Indian Fork of Six Mile Creek to Henry T. Montfort of the same place for \$70. The parcel of land was bounded by ... three sycamores in the bed of Indian fork of Six Mile thence N8 1/4 W62 poles to a stone in said creek thence up said creek with its several meanders S64 1/4 E28 poles to the beginning. Signed by Benjamin and Pamela with their X marks before witness Frances Scroggins, the deed was proved by Benjamin and Pamela in Shelby County Court on 20 January 1860.<sup>20</sup>

Although he is known to have lived there in 1850, Benjamin Scroggin (F45) does not appear on the Federal census for Shelby County or neighboring Franklin County, so he was either missed or his tabulation was lost. On 26 June 1860 he was enumerated as a resident of the Christiansburg Post Office area, District 2, Shelby County with real estate valued at \$2300 and personal property worth \$3240.<sup>21</sup>

If Benjamin really was 49 in June 1860, then perhaps he was born in June 1811 instead of January. Pamela (Amelia) would become 46 in November 1860. Of the children, only the age of Joanna is correct. Catherine was 21, Frances was 19, William was 17, John was 15 and daughter Pamela (Amelia) was only 7 in 1860.

Newton and Elvira Scroggin Miles were also counted in Shelby County, with \$1800 of real estate and \$300 in personal property:<sup>22</sup>

The area where Benjamin Scroggin resided is in the northeastern part of Shelby County. A deed to Joseph Mills for 137 acres on the waters of Six Mile Creek and the Frankfort-New Castle Road described the land as being bounded by land of Benjamin Scroggin in the bed of Indian Fork and by land of Royal Wade.<sup>23</sup>

The road from Frankfort to New Castle now carries several segment names. It is the Mount Zion Road in Franklin County where it parallels the county line. After it turns to cross into Shelby County, it passes through the village of Jacksonville and becomes the Rattletrap-Jacksonville Road. The next section is Elmburg-Rattletrap Road. Beyond Elmburg the road passes into Henry County and on to New Castle. It crosses Six Mile Creek at the junction of Elmburg-Rattletrap and Rattletrap-Jacksonville segments. Indian Fork enters Six Mile Creek just below this point. The mill that belonged to Benjamin and Samuel Scrogin was just downstream from the bridge across Six Mile before it is joined by Indian Fork. Stones of the mill foundation remain and a ditch that once was the millrace is recognizable. Many Indian artifacts have been found in this area, which is now a corn field, such as arrowheads, spear heads, axe heads, and stone tools. The present owner, Julian Wood, retired postmaster of Bagdad, allowed the compiler to select some arrowheads from his collection taken from the site.

The home of Benjamin Scrogin (F45) and Pamela Bohannon was east of the present road and south of the mill, on a hillside overlooking the confluence of the creeks. An 1882 map shows that it was reached by a private road that ran up the hill from the highway by the Grist Mill and traversed the ridge between the streams before turning down to the road to Bagdad. The private drive served the residences of P. Scroggins, G. Davis and S. Bohannon. Other near neighbors of Pamela Scrogin in 1882 were Mary C. Hayden, Mrs. Mary Hayden, M. J. Montfort, N. Flood, J. W. Demaree, W. Radcliff and J. G. Flood.<sup>24</sup>

Other residents along Indian Fork, north of Bagdad, were J. B. Radford, R. M. Redmon, R. H. Pace, T. D. Wilson, S. F. Harrod, S. B. Miles, Mrs. Sally Cook and G. Bondurant. The area drained by Six Mile Creek and its tributaries such as Indian Fork, including the towns of Bagdad and Christiansburg and extending north to Henry County, was known as Christiansburg Precinct No. 3 of Shelby County. The adjacent area east of Indian Fork, extending to Henry County on the north and to Franklin County on the east, including the communities of Consolation, Jacksonville, Stringtown, Scrabble and North Benson (Hatton), was Jacksonville Precinct No. 9 of Shelby County. The residence of William Samuel Scrogin was near Jacksonville on the road to Consolation. Some of his neighbors were T. D. Kesler, Jack Kesler, J. D. Jesse, N. Miles, S. Miles, H. Harrod, C. Onan, James Johnson, A. Cook, W. Cook, Mrs. Cook, M. Hazlett, J. Johnson, T. J. Vardeman (Vardman), Mrs. J. Bohannon, I. Wade, J. Wade, A. Wade, H. Snook, H. F. Bohannon, P. Wade, J. Yount, J. S. Stapleton and Lee Tharp. School No. 5 and Indian Fork Baptist Church were nearby.

Christiansburg Post Office was established on 21 December 1825 and served the area now covered by the Bagdad Post Office which replaced the Christiansburg facility on 12 October 1861.

Benjamin Scrogin was opposed to the Ku Klux Klan when it appeared in Shelby County. There was a great deal of excitement in the area of Bagdad and Christiansburg in 1871 when his brother-in-law, Hiram Bohannon, killed Addison Cook, a leader of the Klan in the county who had threatened his life. After Bohannon was convicted of the murder and sentenced to

hang, his attorneys filed an appeal. When the Court of Appeals ordered a new trial, Benjamin Scrogin, Leroy Kesler and N. Flood co-signed a \$10,000 bond so that Bohannon could be released from jail while awaiting the retrial. Eventually the Commonwealth's Attorney moved to dismiss the case and the new trial was never held.<sup>25</sup>

The writing in the original will of Benjamin Scrogin (F45) and his signature are so similar that it appears that he wrote it himself. In it, which was written on 20 April 1875 and proved at the June term of the Shelby County Court that year, he identified himself as a farmer and named as legatees his wife Permelia M. Scrogin; his children: John C. Scrogin, who he described as an imbecile, Joanna Scrogin, Elvira Miles, Louisa Harrod, Catherine Bohannon, Permelia Montfort and William Scrogin; and Pryor, Coleman, Bennie and Sallie Stivers, who were heirs of Frances Stivers, deceased:<sup>26</sup>

I Benjamin Scrogin of the County of Shelby and State of Kentucky (Farmer) declare this to be my Last will and testament. 1 I give and bequeath to my wife Permelia Scrogin all my personal estate, Stock, household & kitchen furniture Farming utensils &c &c Except what is hereinafter named. Also all monies cash notes and accounts of which I may die possessed. after the payment of my just debts and funeral Expenses.

2 I also give and bequeath to my wife P. M. in addition to her dower interest in the home farm all that portion or parcel of Land formerly purchased by me of Nathaniel Flood Containing about Fifty one (51) acres Specially for and in Consideration of the Care and maintenance of my Son John Scrogin (who is an imbecile) and in event of the death of my wife P. M. prior to my Son John it is my will that Said parcel of land Shall be held by proper guardian appointed by my wife or the County Court To Secure its rents and profits for the Care and maintenance of my Son J. C. during his natural life when Said Land be divided among my children or their heirs

3 I give and devise to my daughter Joanna Scrogin one (1) Sorrel mare three years old

4 I give and devise to my children Elvira Miles, Louisa Harrod, Catherine Bohannon Permelia Montfort Joanna Scrogin Wm. Scrogin and the heirs of Frances Stivers to wit (Pryor Stivers, Coleman Stivers, Bennie Stivers, and Sallie Stivers her child's part) their heirs and assigns all the Land not otherwise devised upon which I live together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the above named premises as described to the Said E M. L H. C B. P M J S. W. S. & F S Decd. their heirs and assigns forever and if any of my children Shall die without heirs then their Legacy to sink into my residuary Estate.

I hereby appoint my wife Permelia Scrogin who shall execute without any surety the Sole Executor of This will revoking all former wills by me made.

In witness whereof I Benj Scrogin have to this my last will and testament,  
Consisting of one sheet of paper Subscribed my name this 20th day of April 1875

After the death of Pamela Bohannon Scrogin, Joanna Scrogin Montfort (G67) took care of John Coleman Scrogin (G63). From 1907 through 1915, her husband T. H. Montfort served as John's guardian. According to the guardian report filed in 1915,<sup>27</sup> John Scrogin was 70 years old and destitute of mind from birth. Traditionally, John was mentally retarded after a serious illness as a small child. The death certificate of John C. Scroggins reports that he died of hypertrophy of the heart at 700AM on 24 June 1915 at Bagdad in Shelby County. The condition that caused his death had endured for five years. The attending physician was J. F. Adams of Bagdad. John was described as a male, white, single farmer who was born in Kentucky on 13 December 1844 and died at age 70 years, 6 months and 11 days. His father was Ben Scroggins and his mother's maiden name was Bohannon. Both were natives of Kentucky. The informant was T. H. Montfort of Bagdad. John was buried at Indian Fork on 25 June 1915.<sup>28</sup>

Thomas Hertell Montfort who married Joanna Scrogin (G67) was a son of Henry Montfort and Martha Jane Kesler who were married on 16 November 1843. He was born on 07 June

1854, died on 30 December 1930 and is buried in Bagdad Cemetery.<sup>29</sup> He and Joanna were married in Shelby County on 29 September 1875 by T. M. Daniel, M.G., with J. Roberts and Sallie Vardeman as witnesses. W. S. Scrogins was surety on the bond.<sup>30</sup> They had one child, a daughter Leila Vaughn Montfort (H128) who was born on 28 June 1879. She married Leonard Martin Fry on 04 May 1898 and also had an only daughter Eva Christine Fry (J102) who was born on 24 April 1899. Leonard Martin Fry was born on 31 August 1870 and died on 23 May 1945. Christine Fry married Oscar Harvey Merchant on 20 December 1922 and had three children, Leila Vada Merchant (K66), who was born on 27 December 1923 and married (1) Joseph Robertson, Jr. and (2) William Shipley; James Leonard Merchant (K67), who was born on 25 March 1927 and married Bonnie Bligh Reasor on 16 July 1948; and John Oscar Merchant (K68), who was born on 11 November 1933 and married Phyllis Bancroft on 19 August 1958. Oscar Merchant died on 06 June 1935.<sup>31</sup>

Joanna "Josie" Scrogin Montfort (G67) died at Bagdad on 05 February 1922 from an indecipherable nephritis condition that had existed for three years, complicated by a secondary illness, la grippe. Her doctor was W. P. Burke of Shelby County. She was described by the informant T. H. Montfort of Bagdad, as a female, white, married and at home. She was born in Shelby County, Kentucky, on 30 October 1855 and was 66 years, 2 months and 5 days old when she died, which is an incorrect calculation. Her parents were Ben Scroggins and Pamela Bohannon, both natives of Shelby County, Kentucky, however Benjamin actually was born in Bourbon County, Kentucky. Josie was interred in Bagdad Cemetery on 07 February 1922 by R. L. Shannon, undertaker of Shelbyville.<sup>32</sup>

Henry Thomas Montfort, Jr. and Amelia Scrogin (G61), daughter of Benjamin Scrogin, were married on 13 December 1869 in Shelby County by minister Andrew Jackson before witnesses H. Montfort and W. E. Waller. William S. Scrogins was bondsman.<sup>33</sup>

Mary Edna Wade who married William Samuel Scrogin (G60) was a daughter of William Wade and Louisa Crook Johnson. Her father was dead when she was married on 25 January 1866 by T. M. Daniel in Shelby County. John Miles was their bondsman. William S. Scrogin was 23, a farmer born in Shelby County, as were his parents. Mary E. Wade, aged 18, daughter of Louisa Wade, was a native of Shelby County, as were her parents.<sup>34</sup>

On 28 May 1863 Jane C. Scroggin (G65) and Monroe Flood witnessed the wedding of Nathaniel Flood, a 45-year-old farmer, and Cecilia Pearson, aged 26. It was his third marriage and her first. Both were born in Shelby County. Her parents were natives of Kentucky and his of Virginia.<sup>35</sup> Jane Catherine Scroggin and Henry G. Bohannon were married on 26 April 1866 in Shelby County by J. D. Bohannon. Harvey Bohannon was bondsman.<sup>36</sup>

Matthias H. Stivers and Frances Scroggins (G66), daughter of Benjamin Scroggins, who secured the bond, were married on 19 October 1860 in Shelby County by Benjamin Onan with Peter Vardeman and Samuel Bohannon as witnesses.<sup>37</sup> They had four children, Pryor (H71), Coleman (H72), Bennie (H73) and Sallie (H74) who survived her and were heirs of their grandfather Benjamin Scrogin (F45). Pryor Stivers died on 18 November 1880. W.

Bennie Stivers died on 09 May 1922 at Bagdad. The family Bible record shows that Frances M. Stivers died on 24 May 1870 but her tombstone at Indian Fork Baptist Church shows that she died in 1871 and gave her middle initial as A:

William Elza Wade who married Louisa Scrogin (G64) was a son of Royal Wade, Jr. and Rebecca Miles. He was a first cousin of Mary Edna Wade who married William Samuel Scrogin (G60). William E. Wade and Louisa Scrogin, daughter of Benjamin Scrogin, who was bondsman, were wed in Shelby County on 14 October 1852 by T. M. Daniel. William Bohannon, James Wilcoxson and James Wade were witnesses.<sup>38</sup> In his will, dated 09 October 1867 William E. Wade named his wife Louisa and his minor children Kendrick Wade, Cynthia A. Wade, James C. Wade, Royal W. Wade and Oscar P. Wade. His executors were wife Louisa and her father Benjamin Scrogin. Witnesses were F. M. Bohannon, Lee Tharp and Newton Miles.<sup>39</sup> Elzy Wade and Louisa Scrogin Wade Harrod are buried at Indian Fork Baptist Church with their son Benoni Kendrick Wade and his wife Eliza Miles Wade:

The parents of James and Louisa were described as natives of Kentucky.

Kendrick Wade (H75) and Eliza Miles were the parents of William Wade (J135), who had a son Leonard Wade (K109), and James Wade (J136), who was childless. Annie Wade Wiley (H76) had Eddie Wiley (J137), Roy Wiley (J138), Lula Wiley Hibbs (J139) and Ella Wiley Hollis (J140). James C. Wade (H77) had Nellie Wade Harris (J141), who had no issue, Lee Wade (J142) and Russell Wade (J143). Royal W. (N?) Wade (H78), whose name was pronounced Ryle, had one child John Wade (J144) who was a telegraph operator for the Chesapeake and Ohio Rail Road in Montgomery, West Virginia, when last known. Oscar P. Wade (H79) was the father of Clancy Wade (J145), Anna Wade Stolker (J146) and Robert Wade (J147).<sup>41</sup>

Newton Miles, aged 22, born and living in Shelby County, and Elvira Scrogin (G62), aged 17, born and living in Shelby County, daughter of Benjamin Scrogin, who was surety on the bond, were married by minister B. T. Quinn in Shelby County on 12 August 1852. The ceremony was witnessed by T. H. Hodges and W. C. Scofield.<sup>42</sup> Newton Miles was born on

29 November 1829, died on 01 March 1902 and is buried at Indian Fork Baptist Church. Newton and Elvira Miles were enumerated on the 1880 census:<sup>43</sup>

A contemporary of Benjamin Scrogin and his children, whose connection with the family is unknown, came to an untimely demise in California in the silver mining town of Calico which is located in the foothills north of Barstow in the Mojave Desert. Established in 1881 and abandoned in 1896, Calico is a ghost town maintained as a tourist attraction by the San Bernardino County Parks Department. In the cemetery at Calico, where the graves are covered with mounds of loose stones, is a marker inscribed:

Francis apparently moved to York Co, PA about 1778 and from there served in the regiment commanded by Hugh Campbell during the Revolutionary War. In 1781-82, he moved with his wife and children to Kentucky with the Low Dutch Colony led by his father in law, Hendrick Banta 3rd. I believe he came in the second wave of colonists from York Co, the first arrived in 1782 and Montfort probably within the year. Source: E-mail, Barbara Whiteside, 5/20/2000.

In 1805 a group of men came to KY from the east with talk of a new religion, being strong in their faith, the men and women of the Dutch community responded overwhelmingly and many of the men and women were the first to join the Society of Believers or Shakers,



sometimes called Quakers [because of their constant moving about as they practiced their religion. They danced and shook, shouted and whirled about and sang at the top of their lungs, loud enough to be heard miles away, from descriptions recorded about them.] Francis Sr. did not join the Shakers, but his wife, Charity Banta Montfort did, along with her son, Francis, his wife, Polly Banta Montfort, and their three children. Francis Sr remained on his farm along the Shelby/Henry Co, KY line in what was called the Low Dutch Colony, land bought from Squire Boone Jr., brother of Daniel. Francis died Apr 22, 1825 and is buried on the Bergen Farm that became the Pleasureville Cemetery in Shelby Co., KY Charity moved to Pleasant Hill, KY in Mercer Co, also known as Shakertown, remaining there until her death Dec 6, 1828. She is buried in the Shaker Cemetery at Pleasant Hill. Some of the info I have sent here includes Lydia Montfort's parents & gparents, but there is no-one in the family (that I know of) named David Montfort. Sorry I keep harping about the Montforts, but my grandmother (nee Shirley Lydia Cook) kept telling me as a child that I'd been "born into royalty." <g> The theory goes that way back in the Dark Ages(!), our ancestor was Simon de Montfort, but if so, there are probably 20 generations or more until my first recorded Montfort, Francis, who emigrated from Germany with his wife "Charity" Banta, & became, according to another genealogist in the Wristen branch of the family, Shakers (who had to swear vows of abstinence, but that was after, apparently, they had a slew of children!). Interesting stuff, huh?

5/25/2000 E-mail from Barbara Whiteside:

I think I know where she (Carol De Priest) is getting much of her information. There is a book about the Vories-Montfort families, that goes into the line of Simon de Montfort of Normandy, France, who crossed to England with William the Conqueror. While at some point there may be a kinship, I have the family back to about 1572 and it does not connect at that point. I can send you my sources of information, books, websites, etc. Been doing this since I was ten, gathering information, then at I 20 I began working at the Indiana History Room of the New Albany, Indiana public library. All told it has been a hobby for something like 47 years now. And it was the Montfort name that set me off on this long journey.

It is true about the Shakers, they did practice celibacy and the early Low Dutch of Shelby and Henry Counties were the first to join when the religion arrived in Kentucky in 1805. The David I descend from, who married Mary Cook, was with them from birth till he reached the age of 20 plus, departing or running away shortly before he turned 21. He had a brother and sister who also ran away. Their parents remained there, as well as 2 grandmothers and a

grandfather [he went to South Union Shaker Village near Bowling Green, KY, died and is buried there.]

Another cousin and I are working on tying up the loose ends of our Montfort family and as they were Shakers, it has taken us a bit, to piece things together through the Shaker journals. I have read all of the ones on microfilm at the Filson Club in Louisville, on Pleasant Hill and the ones for South Union. I am working on reading all the journals not microfilmed this summer at the manuscript dept at the Filson. Western Reserve Historical Society in Cleveland, Ohio has more of the journals, and quite a few that deal with Pleasant Hill or Shakertown as it more commonly known. I am working on getting interlibrary loan to read some of the years that are pertinent to my research.

I also have a picture, xerox of original, of Frances Wilcoxson Cook, mother of Mary, Nancy and Helen. A cousin in Oklahoma has the original and made copy for me. She bears quite a resemblance to the two daughters I have pictures of.

The source of the Montforts being from Germany is I believe from the Vories-Montfort book, but I have plenty of documentation that the family came to New Amsterdam in 1624 from Holland. One line that connects to the Montforts and Bantas, the Demarests, did go from France to Germany for awhile before emigrating. The Montforts lived near the town of Cambrais, in northern France, near what is now the border with Belgium, Germany and Holland. The earliest Montfort in this country arrived on the EENDRACHT [Unity] from Holland with the first boat of settlers with the Dutch West Indies Company. Only two families are documented in Holland and New York, to have been on the boat, and one is the Montforts. They stayed a short time, returned to Holland, then came back in 1639 with a son and daughter in law and this time stayed. This is the line that all the Montforts in America come down from. Many are in Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Ohio, and Kentucky, then scatter from there in 1800's. Through this line of Montforts, we are eligible for the Huguenot Society of America. And through David, his father, Francis Jr. and Mary Cook, I can go into DAR on no less than 12 lines, two Montforts, 2 Bantas, 2 Wilcoxens, a Craig, a Faulkner and 4 women of those same names.

As for the Shaker connection with the Montforts, there were at last count, 47-50 Banta and Montforts that became Shakers in 1805-1807 and many remained there till death. I have a copy of the Shaker Burial Ground at Pleasant Hill with so many familiar names in it.
