The Washington Figure Skating Club, founded in 1938 and located in the Washington DC metropolitan area, is a member club of U.S. Figure Skating, the governing body for figure skating in the United States. The purpose of the WFSC is to foster and encourage the development of figure skating. The Club's activities are designed to serve a full range of figure skating interests — competitive free skating, pairs, dance, synchro, and theater on ice, as well as social ice dancing, basic skills development and recreational skating. The WFSC manages regular skating sessions with qualified professional instructors and provides its members with periodic opportunities to take USFS tests and compete in USFS sanctioned events.

Membership

First Family Member dues: \$75

- ✚ Membership in U.S. Figure Skating, if WFSC is designated as Home Club;
- ✚ Eligibility to participate in USFS sponsored competitions and tests;
- ✚ A one year family subscription to *Skating*, the official magazine of USFS;
- ✚ Unlimited WFSC session subscription and pick-up privileges;
- ✚ A vote in the WFSC Club election for the Board of Governors, if 18 or over.

Subsequent Family Member dues: \$55 per additional family member

- ✚ Same benefits as First Family Member

Non-Skating Memberships:

Parent Member dues: \$30 Available to one parent per family with a skating member under age 18. Includes USFS dues and a vote in the WFSC Board of Governors election. (Available to 1 parent per family of a skating member under the age of 18).

Social Membership dues: \$10 Retains WFSC affiliation with Club publications and invitations to Club events but without USFS membership, voting, or skating privileges.

Home Club must be specified. If WFSC is your “home club,” you are registered with USFS through the WFSC. You may only change home club once a year. If you change mid-year, a form signed by an officer from the previous club must be submitted by the new home club to USFS. Remember, that in order to take a test or receive permission to test elsewhere, you **MUST** be a member of WFSC one month before the test. See application for rush charge information.

Financial Policy

- ✚ Membership dues are not refundable. The Board of Governors of the WFSC will consider written requests directed to the Treasurer (address below) for refund of unused subscription fees if justified by reasons of health, injury or relocation from the area.
- ✚ There will be a \$35 charge for returned checks.
- ✚ If a session falls on a religious holiday, subscribers may request a session pass to skate at other WFSC session.
- ✚ If a scheduled session is canceled, subscribers may receive either a credit or a pass to skate at any other WFSC session.
